



SRM 350, 450 v2 vs v3

Question: For digital percussion which speaker would be best? The SRM450v2 is reviewed and recommended. Would I be gaining or losing anything by getting the v3?

Answer: Well the voicing for the V3 has been completely re-done. There is brand spanking new DSP correction happening in the unit that really helps the unit sound amazing. It really helps focus in on those high frequencies that might not have been as tight in the v2 models. Overall the units sound cleaner, brighter, and packs a punch. The V3 also has the benefit of having all new powerful amplifiers and new drivers to handle the higher wattage.

The other really cool thing on the V3 is the back panel of the unit. There are a bunch of tools back there to help you out, you have a 2 channel mixer built right into the unit, you have an automatic feedback destroyer and several different options in terms of voicing and how the unit sounds depending on the application.

I would say you would be missing out by purchasing an older model.
