

Mackie Tech Support - VLZ3 4-bus Install and Setup for Windows 7

This document will go through the setup and install of a VLZ 4-Bus series mixer including the 2404-VLZ3 and 3404-VLZ3 to a Windows 7 PC. The VLZ3 4-bus series has a built in USB 4x2 24-bit USB audio interface. If you connect the 4-bus to a Window 7 PC you'll only see two recording inputs on your PC. The below steps will show you how to install the USB driver to allow you to use all four inputs from the VLZ3 4-Bus.

Below is a picture of the Control Panel>Hardware and Sound>Sound>Recording without the USB driver installed:

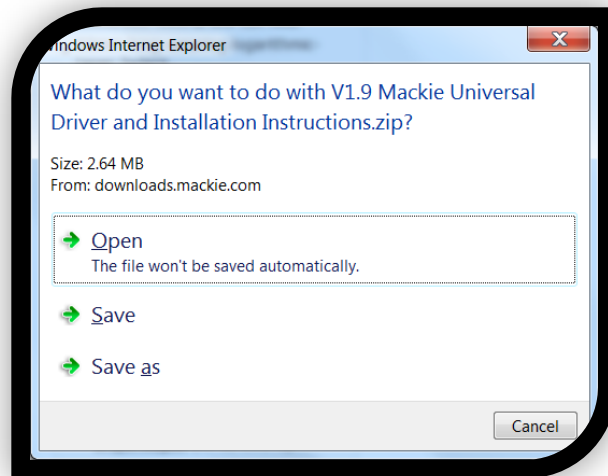


1. Download the USB driver from the product page for the VLZ3 4-bus. Found here:

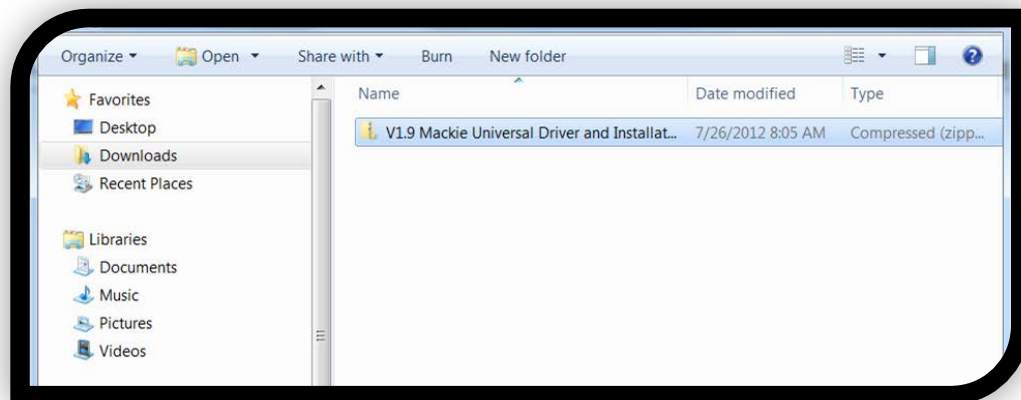
Go to the download section and click on VLZ3 4-Bus driver:



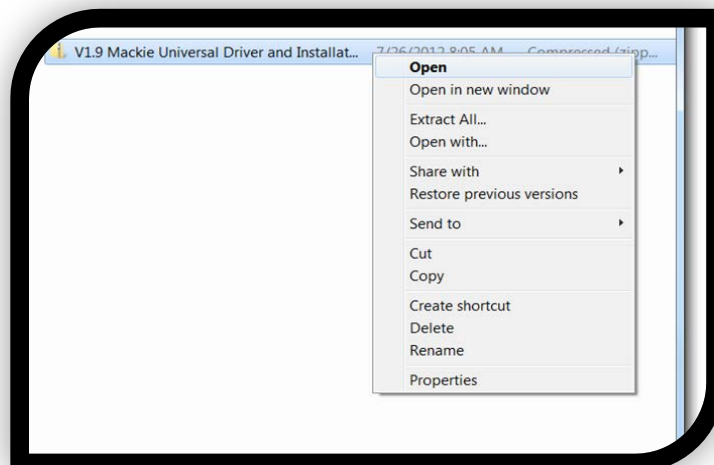
Click save:



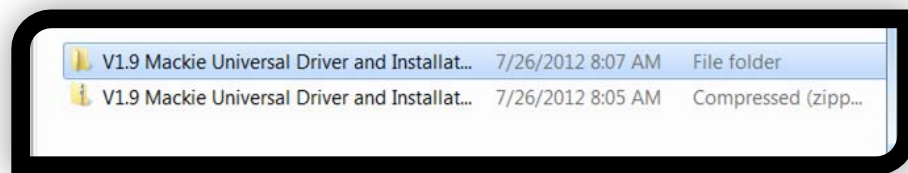
Now the driver is located in your documents>downloads folder:



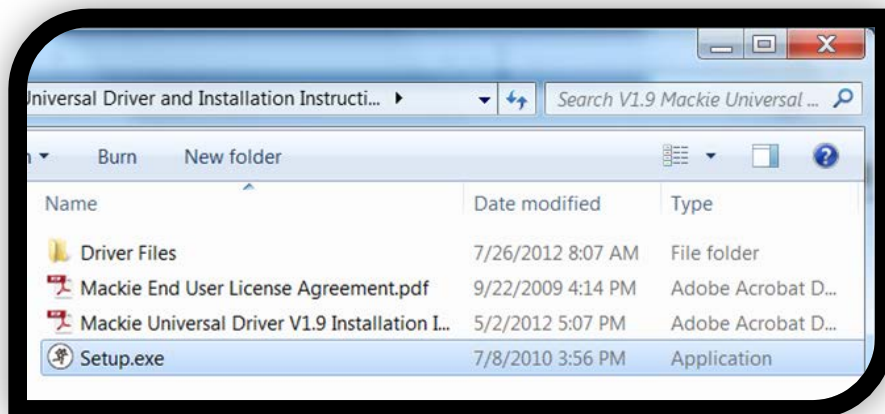
Before you open the folder, you need to extract and unzip the folder. Right click on the folder and select extract all.



2. Now, there will be two folders one unzipped and another zipped:



3. Open the unzipped folder and select the double click on Setup.exe to launch the driver install:



Click next and follow the prompts for the driver installation:



Once the driver has finished installing, go to Control Panel>Hardware and Sound>Sound>Recording



Congratulations the VLZ3 4-Bus is now ready for your PC and you'll see analog inputs 1-2 and 3-4 available in your sound control panel.
